



How to find your 2003 Full Cash Value

If you purchased your home before December 31, 2003, you can call your county Assessor's Office and ask for your 2003 Full Cash Value and current tax information. Or, in Maricopa County you can go to the Assessor's website at www.maricopa.gov/assessor and then:

Select ***Advanced Search***

Fill in name, or address, or parcel number information.

Select ***View Tax Information*** on the **Owner Information** line

Select ***Valuations*** on the top menu bar, then select the year in the dropdown box.

Select ***2003***.

Under Secondary Valuations, find ***Land/Improve FCV*** (Full Cash Value). This amount (the 2003 Full Cash Value) will be the basis for your taxes for as long as you own your property. No more speculative values based on sales or new construction in your neighborhood. No more need for valuation appeals.

CALCULATE YOUR 2011 TAX WITH THE *PROP 13 ARIZONA* FORMULA

Take your 2003 FCV amount (or the purchase price of your home) and multiply by (.005). For example, \$200,000 X (.005) = \$1,000, the maximum tax you could be asked to pay in 2011.

CALCULATE YOUR TAX SAVINGS WITH *PROP 13 ARIZONA*

Take your current property tax amount and subtract the tax you calculated with the above Prop 13 Arizona formula. Continuing the same example, if your current tax is \$1,500. subtract \$1,000. and your first year tax savings is \$500.
